Welcome back to school! The children looked smart and ready for a new year of learning. I look forward to all the fun activities and learning that Oak class will be doing this term. So, this is a breakdown of our learning this term...

In English the children will be completing information text as well as diary entries and stories. The children will embed all the SPaG into their writing.

The children will be reading two books this term. They will complete a novel study of *Stig of the Dump* and *How to wash a woolly Mammoth*.

Our History topic is *Through the Ages*. The children will learn about the Stone Age through to the Iron Age.

The children will research the way they lived, where they settled and how they progressed. They will have an understanding of paleolithic, Mesolithic and neolithic ages.

The children will be learning about Animal nutrition and the skeleton system.

They will be finding out about different types of skeletons.

The children will also be learning about the muscles in the human body and how we use them.



We have our exciting hook day coming up!

On 24th September the children will be going on a trip to Sheringham and West Runton. More details to come soon.

In maths the children will be learning about place value and the four calculations. Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The children will also be focusing on their times tables.

In geography the children will be learning about our world. They will be researching the human features and physical features of different cities and countries around the world. They will use maps to locate places and use grid references. They will also learn about the different climate zones.

In Art the children will be exploring pottery with clay. They will learn different styles and patterns to create their beaker pots. They will be learning about colour theory and using water colours to create master pieces!



The children will be learning how to play the recorder and they will learn how to read music.

In PSHE the children will be learning about: Being Me in my world.

The children will be taught Spanish on a Wednesday with Mrs Sherriff.

In DT the children will be learning about healthy foods. The children will then use this knowledge to produce some delicious dishes in school.
